REFUND POLICY (AFTER WITHDRAWAL)

No refund of any tuition, fees, room, or board charges will be made in the event that a student withdraws from the College at any time after registering for a term except as herein specified. In no event is the \$250 enrollment deposit fee refundable. A student's withdrawal date is:

- > The date the student begins the institution's withdrawal process and officially notifies the Registrar's Office of intent to withdraw; or
- > The date identified as the final deadline for receipt of academic work from the student in cases here insufficient academic participation prompts a withdrawal; or
- > The date of an administrative withdrawal from the semester or program initiated by the College.

If the withdrawal is official before the first day of the semester, a full refund of all charges less the \$250 nonrefundable Enrollment Deposit is given. If the official withdrawal occurs on or after the first day of the semester, Goddard College will use the following scale for determination of fee reduction:

1 st Week (day 1-7)	75%	
$2^{nd} - 3^{rd}$ Week (day 8-21)	60%	
4 th – 6 th Week (day 22-42)	50%	
$7^{th} - 8^{th}$ Week (day 43-56)	20%	
After 8 th Week (day 57 plus)	0%	

FINANCIAL AID ADJUSTMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH WITHDRAWAL:

Students considering withdrawing from their program should contact the Student Accounts Office and their Financial Aid Counselor to determine how the withdrawal will affect their Financial Aid. The amount of Financial Aid to be returned is determined by the date on which you withdraw and how much aid you have 'earned'.

After calculating the reduction of your financial aid and tuition, you may owe a balance to the College. Payment of any outstanding balance must be paid in full at time of withdrawal.
